What It Is Exactly?

ExcellaDerm Microdermabrasion treatments are based on an even patented method of polishing and removing the upper-most layer of the skin called the Stratum Corneum. The result is a topical exfoliation as well as an indirect stimulation to the basal layer of the skin. When we stimulate the basal layer of the skin, we increase cell proliferation (turnover), stimulate nervous tissue, resulting in vasodilatation for increased blood flow, and trigger the stimulation of oil and water production. It can also have a direct influence on increased fibroblast, collagen and elastin production. The results: a healthier, more vibrant, firmer, appearance with increased hydration and texture (Good Looking Skin).

How the ExcellaDerm Microdermabrasion Works;

Small crystals of Alumina Oxide (the only FDA approved substrate) are delivered to the skin. The abrasive characteristics of this particulate remove various amounts of dead tissue with the degree of ablation depending on three variables:

1. The level of power used during the session. More passes at a lower setting is recommended.
2. The amount of "time on the tissue". Moving the Hand Piece slowly across the skin results in more ablation (removal of skin); faster across the skin, less ablation.
3. The number of passes on the skin. The more times you pass over a particular area the more ablation you get.

Once the crystals are rotated on the skin, they are vacuumed away by a specially designed hand piece and deposited into the waste canister for later disposal. The vacuum device on our systems has additional benefits. As the hand piece glides over the surface of the skin, the vacuum acts as a stimulant to increase blood flow to nourish the skin, as well as to accelerate collagen and elastin production. The result is a firmer, toned and glowing appearance.

Why Should You Have An ExcellaDerm Microdermabrasion Treatment?

You can decrease Acne, Hyper-Pigmentation, (dark spots) Fine Lines and Wrinkling as well as Dull, Dry and Aging Skin. Under normal circumstances, the uppermost skin layer exfoliates naturally between 10-12 days. New cells in the basal cell layer take 28-30 days to rise to the surface and ultimately slough away. By removing dry dead skin cells with microdermabrasion, new living cells that are deeper in the tissue are revealed, showing healthy skin. Microdermabrasion accelerates the migration of the new cells to the surface. By having Microdermabrasion (only ExcellaDerm) treatments **you can take an active part in removing basil cells at a accelerated rate thus helping to prevent or discourage basil cell buildup which may cause dangerous carcinomas.**

Microdermabrasion works best when performed as a series of 6 or sometimes 8 procedures at one week intervals. More severe problem skin may require additional procedures to obtain the desired results. After a series of procedures, we recommend that once every 4 to 6 weeks a maintenance or "refresher" treatment (At the very least 4 per year to keep your skin vibrant).

Skin sensitivity to our microdermabrasion treatment is practically not existent and post procedure discomfort is very unlikely. To protect the skin following a procedure, we recommend non-chemical sun block. We also recommend the use of the appropriate non-irritating skin care products to assist in the repair process and to ensure optimum results. Remember Microdermabrasion can be used on your entire body. Neck, Shoulders, Arms, Hands, Décolleté, Psoriasis Patches, Back Acne, Scars, and Stretch Marks. **Keep this in mind!**
